SECTION III: PROGRAM SUMMARY

Weatherization Inc. is a private non-profit 501 C-3 organization. Weatherization Inc. is a multi-program agency. Examples of other programs are Housing Rehabilitation, Customer Assistance and WARM weatherization through and electric utility company, and Housing Preservation Grant. We provide the weatherization services through the use of sub-contracting companies. Clients to be served are those that are at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. Housing stock types to be served in Huntingdon County are single family dwellings, multi-family dwellings and mobile home owners and renters. Weatherization uses a point and ranking system that is approved by DCED and incorporated in the HES system. Weatherization Inc. uses advertising in local newspapers, solicitations and referrals from other human service agencies throughout Huntingdon County as well as referrals from clients at the time of final inspection. We also solicit by mailings and phone calls to clients from the Liheap recipient lists. Local utility companies refer from their programs.

Consumer energy conservation education activities include and energy education session conducted at the time of each initial inspection. Weatherization uses a variety of educational materials and handouts at the time of audit. We require each client to sign a receipt acknowledging receipt of these activities.
